

The garrison of the fortress did not exceed 3000 THE FORTIFICATIONS EXTENDED. 129 men, and many of these were in an undisciplined state; amongst them, says Ayala, many vagabonds from Spain and deserters from the Spanish army. Since the place had been in the hands of the English some additions had been made to the defences. Several bastions had been constructed, and the Land Port gate defended with 20 pieces of cannon j a tower was armed to command the enemys camp, and the inundation, which still forms one of the most...
